

Liturgy Commission

Purpose:

The Liturgy Commission is responsible for liturgical functions that serve as the primary demonstrative expressions of faith and worship, as well as program explicitly involving spiritual growth and development. Consequently, this Commission has responsibility for recruiting, training, developing, scheduling and supporting parish members to assist with liturgical celebrations, including Eucharistic ministers, lectors, servers, ushers and greeters. The Liturgy Commission is also responsible for preparing the sanctuary environment for worship, for example by placing flowers, changing fabric, changing banners and placing items needed for the Eucharistic celebration.

Volunteer Opportunities:

- Serve as Eucharistic minister, lector, server, usher, or greeter
- Assist in preparation of the sanctuary environment prior to worship
- Assist in special events, such as missions and special Masses or celebrations
- Assist in cleanup activities after special events
