Please note: If you suspect a child is in danger, please

contact 9-1-1 or your local law enforcement agency.,

unless to do so would violate the Sacrament of Penance.

At the time of reporting, the diocese will request to be

kept informed as to the progress of that authority's

investigation.

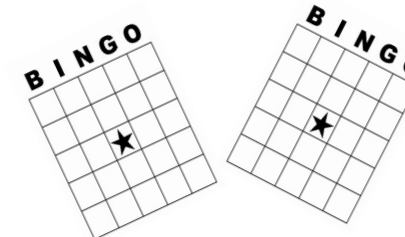
