Citing the Old and New Testament, the Catechism, and his own engaging personal stories, professor and author Dr. Michael Barber explains the “inner logic” of almsgiving, and how this often misunderstood aspect of our faith is a critically important good work, related to our own unmerited redemption in Jesus Christ.

WATCH: Maria Goretti: The Story of the Patroness of Modern Youth Learn more about the holy life and martyrdom of St. Maria Goretti in this moving documentary. In particular, the film highlights her ultimate act of love: forgiving her murderer on her deathbed.
