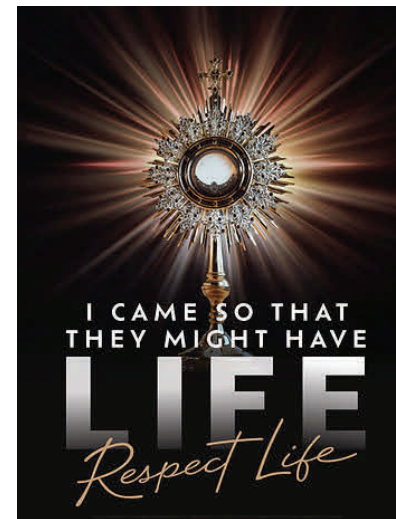
STEWARDSHIP THOUGHT:
